The health of children at a nearby school will certainly be affected, which is unacceptable."


NEW SCHOOLS


It is good to know that a new primary school in Whiteley is due to open in September and that within the next few years a secondary school will be built to ensure all children in that area do not have to travel long distances. Their independence and self confidence can only be enhanced by having to be responsible for getting to and from their school without the need for parental/carer company. Young people who attend Swanmore College are indeed fortunate to live within that catchment area.
