The much-publicised proposals to build homes on the vital Blendworth Lane car park, owned by EHDC, was vehemently opposed by Horndean councillors and the idea has now been shelved.

### GRANTS HELP LOCAL AMENITIES

EHDC Cabinet approved a grant of £150k towards upgrading the all-weather football pitch at Horndean Technology College to a full size adult 3G pitch with community access. Construction is now underway.

### ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS


Environmental matters have always been of high importance for members at EHDC. With climate change now of great concern, the Climate and Environmental Strategy 2020-2025 has been introduced to drive change. The climate crisis and the negative impact on our environment affects us all. EHDC wants to take an inclusive approach and maintain a dialogue on climate issues through their "Let's Talk" initiative.
